

Text Message Phishing Alert

A new phishing threat is currently circulating via text message attempting to obtain debit or credit card information. The message states "THE CREDIT UNION CENTER ALERT: Your CARD has been DEACTIVATED. Please contact us at 806-576-####." This is NOT a legitimate alert text message!!! Do not call the number and provide any information.

The Education Credit Union does not ask our members for such personal information. Anyone who receives such a text message should consider it to be a fraudulent attempt to obtain their personal account data for an illegal purpose and should not follow the instructions contained in the text message.
