If you do not meet minimum qualification requirements but maintain a minimum \$1,000 average daily balance during the monthly qualification cycle, 0.10% APY will apply to the entire balance. 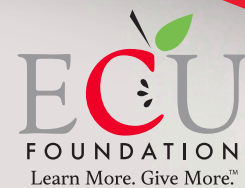

Apply Now for Our Student Scholarships!

Graduating seniors can apply for a membership scholarship provided by the ECU Foundation.

Four applicants will receive \$1,000 each semester for four semesters as long as they maintain the minimum eligibility requirements.

- Applicants must be a member of ECU at least one full year prior to application.
- Applicants must plan to enroll on a full-time basis (12 credit hours).
- Applicants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA.

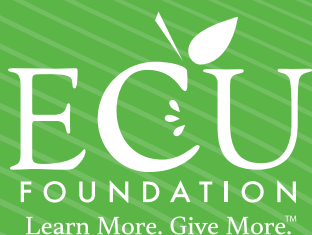
